ANDY LIM

Mr. Andy Lim is the Founder and Chairman of private equity firm Tembusu Partners and the Chairman and controlling shareholder of a publicly listed company Viking Offshore & Marine Limited. He is also the Executive Director of Associated Leisure International, a family holding company and Chairman of Money World Group of Companies. His latest initiative is the launch of South East Asia’s first equity and lending based Crowd Funding platform FundedHere.com in Singapore.



His other Board appointments include Chairman of the Overseas Experts Council (Singapore Branch) of Peking University’s China Centre for Strategic Studies, President of the Enterprise 50 Association, a leading association of the top 50 privately held companies in Singapore and a member of the Home Affairs Uniformed Service (HUS) INVEST Board of Trustee. He was the Chairman of Alpha Singapore (2002 – 2013), Council Member of the National Council for Anti-Drug Abuse (NCADA) (2005 – 2012) and as Chairman of government cooperative for ex-offenders, ISCOS (2006 – 2012). In September 2004, Mr Lim was appointed Honorary Consul to the Republic of Lithuania. The Shanghai-Pudong Branch of the China Overseas Friendship Association also appointed him as one of its Council members in May 2005.

Mr Lim took an Overseas Merit Scholarship to study Engineering in Cambridge University where he graduated with First Class Honors in 1979. After an 8 year stint with the Singapore government, he went on to receive an MBA Degree at University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA) in 1989.
