It also discusses the best practice guidelines for board composition and procedures as well as board member insurance.

Currently, he is serving on the Board of Vilniaus vandenys, the largest water supply company in Lithuania, and chairing the Board of the European Confederation of Directors Associations (ecoDa).

Andris Grafs is the Vice President Latvia of the BICG. Among other things, he is a co-author of the Latvian Corporate Governance Code, a co-author of the Latvian Government's concept of reforms on the governance of state-owned companies and respective national legislation, and one of the authors of a binding ownership policy on how Riga city-owned companies are governed.
